



Mark 8:1-10 (selected verses 2-4)—² “I have compassion for these people; they have already been with me three days and have nothing to eat. ³ If I send them home hungry, they will collapse on the way, because some of them have come a long distance.” ⁴ His disciples answered, “But where in this remote place can anyone get enough bread to feed them?”

Following Jesus, we must practice compassion.

- Jesus showed concern for physical needs.

Following Jesus, we must practice conviction.
