

Luke 2:14, **Why Jesus Came**, McKinney Christmas 2021, 8:30, 9:45, 11:00

**Read Luke 2:7-14** Pray: We ask that we could understand today in this room what heaven understood and announced 2000 years ago. God help me to explain **Why Jesus our savior did come forth to die?**

**Me/We:** Conflict in our culture. Maybe you felt it at the thanksgiving table.

**God:** *Jesus came (why) to give us peace and God glory.*

- “Peace” in the Bible is calm in the midst of conflict. not simply the absence conflict but a divine social order of well-being and prosperity, security and harmony. A life where **All is well** at the core of who we are.
- Why does Jesus coming give us peace? **Peace on earth and mercy mild God and sinners (living our way and not God’s way) reconciled... Jesus came (why)**
- “..with whom he is pleased.” Rom. 5:1–2 Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Eph 2 – with man – breaking down the dividing wall of hostility.

**You:** Do you believe that *Jesus came (why) to give us peace with God?*

*Me this spring stressed, overwhelmed – Peace - a divine social order of well-being and prosperity, security and harmony... A life where All is well*

Series: Disciples experiences this peace: Daily, Weekly, and through Simplicity.

**We:** When we live believing that *Jesus came (why) to give us peace... we give God glory. Joy to the world!* The Lord is come Let earth receive her King! Let every heart prepare Him room... *when hearts have prepared him room... Heaven and nature sing... And He shall reign forever!*

**O Holy Night** – Long lay the world in sin and error pining (suffer mental and physical decline) till he appeared and the soul felt its worth (peace with God)

Conclusion – Text rescue to 50700, Advent Blocks. Exit through front doors.
