### **Genesis 2:9, 16 (NLT)**

'The Lord God made all sorts of trees grow up from the ground—trees that were beautiful and that produced delicious fruit. In the middle of the garden he placed the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. But the Lord God warned him, "You may freely eat the fruit of every tree in the garden—"except the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. If you eat its fruit, you are sure to die."
